Crocker. General Allen, who worked with Ambassador Crocker in both Iraq (during the surge in 2007-2009) and in Afghanistan (2011-2012), introduced Ambassador Crocker as the dinner's key-note speaker. During his address Ambassador Crocker offered his "lessons learned" over a diplomatic career that spanned four decades.
